

Materials List

**Note: some materials may be purchased from instructor at cost, as indicated below.
Bring materials to the first meeting.**

PAPERS

- **Drawing or sketching** paper; 9" x 12" pad.
- **Water color block, hot press**; 9"x12"; *may be purchased from instructor at approx. \$18.00* . ****Do not buy a cold press block****

PENCILS

- **HB (#2)** – a regular pencil is ok; mechanical ones don't need sharpening
- **Colored Pencils, sharpened; Prismacolor set of 48 recommended, or the following colors:** indigo blue, Tuscan red, olive green, limepeel, lemon yellow, violet, bronze, cloud blue, apple green, cream, canary yellow, chartreuse, black grape, sienna brown, peacock green, sepia, cool grey 70%, terra cotta, pumpkin orange, poppy red, crimson red, carmine red, Spanish orange, goldenrod, light peach. Note: these pencils are recommended; you may not use all of them during the class.
- **Watercolor Pencils: Derwent Watercolour set of 24 recommended**
- **Additional Derwent Watercolour pencil:** blue violet lake. May be purchased from instructor at approx. \$0.90

BRUSH

- **Pentel Aquash water brush, large;** *may be purchased from instructor at approx. \$7.50.*

ERASER

- **White plastic**, such as Staedler Mars, or Clic-erase, Tuff Stuff, etc.

MISC.

- **Small bottle of water from which to fill your brush**
- **Pencil Sharpener**
- **Paper towels**
- **Artist's tape**
- **Drafting brush** for wiping away eraser crumbs
- **Drawing board** (a large clip-board with a smooth surface will do)
- **Tracing paper**
- **Small desk lamp and extension cord**
